

SCARECROW COMPETITION

The Scarecrow Competition is part of the Michaelmas Fayre but to allow time for both Judging and maximum enjoyment of the Scarecrow Trail entries must be on display from

SATURDAY 17th SEPTEMBER to SUNDAY 2nd OCTOBER

COMPETITION

- Free choice of subject BUT there will be an ADDITIONAL prize for the best Scarecrow themed "The Wild West"

CATEGORIES

- **Child/ren** (ages and declaration to be signed by parent/guardian)
- **Individual Adult**
- **Family**
- **Collaborating Group or Organisation** (contact details of one member to be completed on Entry Form)

HOW TO ENTER

- Scarecrow installations must be in place by 5pm on Saturday 17th September and clearly visible from the outside of your property
- Each scarecrow must also display a Scarecrow Trail card with the Title of the Scarecrow and type of entry (e.g. child, group etc.). Cards available from the Community Shop, St James Church, St James Primary from 1st September

Please use the designated space on the ADULT entry form for this competition.

Fee : £3 per entry

RULES

- Your scarecrow must be an original piece of work and made from scratch
- Your scarecrow must be in 'good taste' and suitable for a family event
- Your scarecrow must be able to withstand all weather conditions
- Your scarecrow must be placed on private property and maintained in good order and condition throughout the Scarecrow Trail period. You must have public liability or home insurance for the property
- You must take all reasonable care and responsibility to ensure the safety of the exhibit and people approaching to see it
- General road safety must be considered when determining the placement of your scarecrow
- You are encouraged to use recycled materials
- You may use props and accessories to enhance your scarecrow and to provide context
- Your entry may be made up of multiple scarecrows but you must clearly state this on the Scarecrow Trail Card
