DOG SHOW

CATEGORIES

- Most Appealing Eyes
- Dog most like its Owner
- Best 'Sit'

This is held at 3pm on Butter Cross Green. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and should arrive by 2.45pm. Please ensure you bring your own supply of Poo Bags and if used dispose of them in an official Dog Waste Disposal Bin (one on Main Street WH by the path to Church Street and on Church Street at other end of same path) – or take them home.

Please prepare an A4 card with your dog's name in large letters on it, that is clearly visible to the Judge (attached to your dog or handler).

Please use designated space on the ADULT entry form for this competition. Fee : £3 per dog

FAMILY CHALLENGE competing for the *St James the Great Family Challenge Cup*

This is for 3 members of a family – it can be extended family but you must include the links between the members entering. So grandparents, cousins, your partner's nieces or nephews – all welcome. Each group **MUST** contain one adult and one under 14 year old – the third member of the group can therefore be either a second adult or second child.

COMPETITION

Competitor 1 : Adult : Hand crafted item (any medium)

Competitor 2 : Child : Baked item (e.g. cake, bread, pie, biscuits)

Competitor 3 : Adult or Child : Home grown vegetable

Please use the designated space on the ADULT entry form for this competition.

Fee : £3 per family

SCARECROW COMPETITION

The Scarecrow Competition is part of the Michaelmas Fayre but to allow time for both Judging and maximum enjoyment of the Scarecrow Trail entries must be on display from

SATURDAY 16th SEPTEMBER to SUNDAY 1st OCTOBER

COMPETITION

- Free choice of subject BUT there will be an **ADDITIONAL** prize for the best Scarecrow themed in some way to do with music (e.g. playing an instrument, conductor, vocalist)

CATEGORIES

- **Child/ren** (ages and declaration to be signed by parent/guardian)
- **Individual Adult**
- **Family**
- **Collaborating Group or Organisation** (contact details of one member to be completed on Entry Form)

HOW TO ENTER

- Scarecrow installations must be in place by 5pm on Saturday 16th September and clearly visible from the outside of your property
- Each scarecrow must also display a card with the Title of the Scarecrow and type of entry (e.g. child, group etc.)

Please use the designated space on the ADULT entry form for this competition.

Fee : £3 per entry

RULES

- Your scarecrow must be an original piece of work and made from scratch
- Your scarecrow must be in 'good taste' and suitable for a family event
- Your scarecrow must be able to withstand all weather conditions
- Your scarecrow must be placed on private property and maintained in good order and condition throughout the Trail period. You must have public liability or home insurance for the property
- You must take all reasonable care and responsibility to ensure the safety of the exhibit and people approaching to see it
- General road safety must be considered when determining the placement of your scarecrow
- You are encouraged to use recycled materials
- You may use props and accessories to enhance your scarecrow and to provide context
- Your entry may be made up of multiple scarecrows but you must clearly state this on the information card
